

Copyright Permission to Re-publish PNGHS Yearbooks




These rights will in no way restrict republication of the material in any other form by PGNISD or by others authorized by them.

Good Morning! I have discussed Mrs. Ryan's concerns with Dr. Cavness and we believe changes must be made to protect a particular population of students. In the original agreement, I did not consider our special education students. Our Special Education population is very important to our district and the students in this program sometimes attend school until the age of 21 and sometimes 22. In order to insure that our current students are protected, it is important to push back the on-line posting date from 5 years to 9 years. I sincerely apologize for the oversight and I thank you for your intention to preserve the history of Port Neches-Groves ISD.
